NOTIFICATION

S.O. 4188 WHEREAS by the notification of the Government of India in the Ministry of Steel and Mines (Department of Mines) No. S.O. 2245 dated the 20th August, 1974, under sub-section (1) of section 7 of the Coal Bearing Areas (Acquisition and Development) Act, 1957 (20 of 1957), the Central Government gave notice of its intention to acquire the lands in the locality specified in the Schedule appended to that notification;

AND WHEREAS the competent authority in pursuance of section 8 of the said Act has made his report to the Central Government;

AND WHEREAS the Central Government, after considering the report aforesaid, and, after consulting the Government of Bihar, is satisfied that the lands measuring 599.52 acres (approximately) or 242.61 hectares (approximately) described in the Schedule appended hereto should be acquired;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 9 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby declares that the lands measuring 599.52 acres (approximately) or 242.61 hectares (approximately) described in the said Schedule are hereby acquired.

- D-E Line passes along the part left Bank of River Damodar in village Urimari.


