1. What are the prizes of Coal India Marathon?

Total Prize Money –16.56 X 2 = ₹33.12 Lakhs

Prize Money Rules:

- 1. The prize money is applicable to Indian participants only.
- 2. Top 7 Prize will be awarded based on Gun Time and Not on Chip Time basis.
 - a. Where Gun Time refers to the time that starts the moment the race's official starter fires the starting gun (or equivalent signal). From the moment the gun goes off, the clock is ticking for all runners, regardless of when they cross the start line. We will cross-verify whether the person finishing in top 7 has officially ran the entire course through timing technology and video camera recording on the course.
- 3. On Race Day a victory ceremony will be conducted for the top 7 fastest winners for men & women in FM, HM and 10k Race Category (Results announced on race day are Provisional/ Unofficial)
- 4. All winners will be announced on our website and on our Social Media Channels 7 working days post the event after verification of the document and other camera evidences. They will be provided with their winner's prizes accordingly.
- 5. Runners must cross the start line within 15 minutes of official start time of the prize money race category, to be eligible for timings, rankings and thereby prize money (where applicable).
- 6. Prize winners declared may be required to submit further proof of identity/age as may be required by the organizer for the cash prize which the organiser may at its sole discretion withhold disbursement or disqualify the said participant from the competition.
- 7. All prizes are subjected to taxation, providing age proof and completion of necessary formalities.
- 8. On Investigation, If the runners are found to have interchanged their running number bib and/or bib tag with others, will not be entitled to any timing or prize money (where applicable). Such runners shall also be disqualified from future competitions.
- 9. All claims for prize money made post 14th February, 2024 stand nullified.

Appeals

- 1. All correspondences related to Coal India Marathon 2024 to be made at coalindiamarathonccl@gmail.com
- 2. Any confirmed runner of the Coal India Marathon Ranchi 2024 can lodge a protest in relation to the official race results in relation to the overall finish positions declared after the race but within 2 days from the race day.
- 3. Only the protest received on or before Tuesday, 13th February, 2024, will be entertained. A jury shall deliberate, verify and deliver its decision on the Protest within 7 working days of receiving the Protest.

- 4. The decision will be intimated to the person lodging the protest and shall intimated through mail. The decision of the organizer shall be final and binding on all.
- 5. Timing results: Where the timing result of a runner with respect to his/her gender and/or age, is required to be updated online, the runner needs to send e-mail, no later than 13th February 2024, specifying the nature of edit required and attaching the relevant proof of change. Requests received after 13th February, 2024 will not be entertained.

Terms and Conditions:

Please choose the event category carefully, confirmed registrations are non-refundable, non- transferable and cannot be modified. Provide us with a secure email ID/mobile no that you can access regularly since this will be our primary means of communication during the run-up to the event.

- Users of email services that offer filtering/blocking of messages from unknown email address should add this email id <u>coalindiamarathonccl@gmail.com</u> to their address list.
- We will be sending regular updates to the Mobile number you have provided in the registration form this should be not treated as spam and you shall not take any action against our bulk SMS service provider.
- Any notice sent to the email address registered with the organisers shall be deemed as received by the runners.
- Please fill out only those fields that are necessary for mailing purposes. Do not provide redundant data in multiple fields (i.e., do not list the same data for city, province and country), as this will only complicate our ability to contact you, if necessary.
- You are aware that running long distance running is an extreme sport and can be strenuous for the body and health. You take full responsibility for participating in the Coal India Marathon 2024 and do not hold the organising committee or any of its members or entities responsible for any injury or accident.
- You shall consult your physician and undergo a complete medical examination to assess your suitability to participate in the event.
- You also assume all risks associated with participating in this event including, but not limited to, falls, contact with other participants, the effects of the weather, traffic and the condition of the road, arson or any other threats and all other risks associated with a public event.
- You agree that organiser shall not be liable for any loss, damage, illness or injury that might occur as a result of your participation in the event.
- You agree to abide by the instructions provided by the organisers from time to time in the best interest of your health and event safety.
- You also agree to stop running if instructed by the Race director or the medical staff or by the aid station volunteers.
- You confirm that your name and media recordings taken during your participation may be used to publicise the event.
- You may acknowledge and agree that your personal information can be stored and used by organiser in connection with the organisation, promotion and administration of the event and for the compilation of statistical information.
- You confirm that, in the event of adverse weather conditions, major incidents or threats on the day, any of the force majeure restriction by authority, the organisers reserve the right to stop/cancel/postpone the event. You understand that confirmed registrations and merchandise orders are non-refundable, non-transferable and cannot be modified. The organisers reserve the right to reject any application without providing reasons. Any amount collected from rejected applications alone will be refunded in full (excluding bank charges wherever applicable)
- Runners are recommended to stay off the course beyond the cut-off time considering the safety and traffic regulations.
- For any reason if you cannot turn up on race day, no refund of any form will be given.
- If this registration is being made on behalf of a minor, you confirm that you are the parent / guardian of the child and that he/she has your permission to take part in the event. You further concur that all the above rules shall apply to him/her as if he were a major.

- Participants must personally appear for collecting the running Bibs. Bibs can be distributed inabsentee with the written consent and id proof of the registered runners.
- Participant race number bibs are specific personal identifiers and may not be exchanged with or transferred/ sold to any other person, Sale and/or transfer of race entry/bibs are strictly prohibited and will result in the disqualification and/or banning of any individuals involved from future events.
- Official times for mass participants will be the electronic timing device time (chip time) from when the participant crosses the start line to the point where the participant crosses the finish line.
- Participants must wear their assigned timing device continuously from the start line to finish line, to receive an accurate finish time.
- Participants found to be wearing two or more timing devices during the race will be disqualified and their results will not be recorded.
- Participants with missing timing device times at official checkpoints will be reviewed and may be disqualified.
- Participants must begin the event during the official recognized starting time in order to register for an official course completion time.
 - > Only Indian citizens are eligible to participate in the 2nd Coal India Marathon.
 - > Only on ground event participants who are winners are eligible for prize money.
 - Prize money is subject to change at the discretion of Organisers.
 - > All prizes are applicable for Indian Citizens only.
 - > All prizes are subject to taxation and completion of necessary formalities.
 - > All rights reserved with Central Coalfields Limited (A Subsidiary of Coal India Limited)..
 - > The number of participants will be restricted to 10000.
 - > The organiser reserve the right to close registration fully or category wise.
 - > Right to amend/ remove any clause rest on the organiser.

2. What is the minimum age of participants in all categories?

▶ 18 years and above (Except for 05 KM- non timed and non-prize money race).

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5. What does the registration fee cover?

The registration fee is exclusively for your participation in the Coal India Marathon 2024.

6. What the participants will get?

- Official Race BIB along with the RFID Chip (for timed Run).
- Official T-Shirt
- Goodie Bag
- Water and energy drink along the course.
- Medical Assistance.
- Light Refreshment at finish point.
- E-Timing Certificate (Except 5 KM run)
- Participation e-certificate will be provided for 5 KM run participants also.
 - RFID Chip is only for the prize money race.

7. What is the last day of registration?

28 January 2024 which may be extended or closed prematurely fully or category wise by the organiser.

8. What are the cut off time for all categories?

- To ensure that the timing is recorded, the runner must cross all the timing mats provided at various locations.
- The timing certificate will be provided for runners who have completed full marathon / half marathon / 10 KM within the cut off time.
- The 5 KM run is not a timed event and participants will be provided with a participation certificate.

9. What is the terrain / race route?

- > The start and end point will be Birsa Stadium, Morabadi Ranchi.
- The route promises a peaceful run on a flat track/route.
- 10. Is the race route suitable and supportive for bare footed runner?
 - > No. The race authorities do not allow bare foot running on the route.

11. I haven't received any confirmation message or receipt for the event registered, what should I do?

If you have any queries regarding payment or have not received any confirmation message of your registrations, you can contact us at – (mail ID, Contact Number, Help Desk).

12. Can I register myself for more than one race?

- > No. Individual registration is limited to participation in only one race.
- > In case of multiple registrations, the registration will be cancelled.

13. Can I change my race category after confirmation of my registration for the race?

No. Once the race category has been confirmed, the same can't be changed later.

14. Can I get refund, transfer or donate my registration?

No. We do not have a refund policy. Once a registration is confirmed the registration fee is non-refundable, unless the event gets cancelled. The registration is also nontransferable.

15. Can I apply offline?

> No, only online registration is available.

16. How do I get to the start point?

- > All the races begin at the Birsa Munda Stadium, Morabadi, Ranchi.
- > Click on this Google Maps link to get a sense of venue.

17. Does the venue have parking lot?

> Yes. The parking plan will be provided before the race day.

18. Is there baggage counter at the venue?

We strongly recommend not to carry any baggage. If you are carrying any belongings on the race day, preferably keep them in your vehicles. The organiser of the Coal India Marathon are not responsible for any losses or damage to the belongings. All baggage will be screened for security reasons and we recommend not to have anything valuable or fragile goods in your bag.

19. Will there be aid station and emergence medical assistance along the route?

- > Yes. Participant's health is our foremost priority.
- The route will have adequate aid station, loaded with hydration, energy and medical facilities along the route.
- > Mobile health care units are also available.
- Recovery rooms will be accompanied by a physiotherapist and will be available at the finish point.

20. Is there accommodation available for participants who come from outside?

21. Can I use iPod / Headphones during the race?

Yes. Music can be a great companion. However, don't get carried away. Be alert to signage and announcements of the race marshals.
